

## Fire Wardens / Marshals

### Aims

This one day course aims to develop the knowledge and skills of those responsible for assisting in an emergency situation, or to help with fire risk assessments. The session includes a practical element which involves delegates discharging a variety of client supplied fire extinguishers.

- Outline the main requirements of the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order
- Describe the risk factors associated with fire
- Identify factors involved in fire assessments
- Understand the principals of fire, and fire prevention
- Operate a fire extinguisher safely and correctly
