Manual Handling Assessors

Aims

This two day course aims to develop the knowledge and practical skills with regards to manual handling. The course includes a practical session for delegates to practice their techniques. Ideally clients to provide typical loads to be used in the practical session.

Describe the legal requirements for assessing manual handling risks
Be aware of the scope of the problem within the UK
Consider guidance on lifting weights, and full assessment techniques.
Be aware of the hazards associated with team lifting, and moving loads from awkward places
Conduct a basic lift under supervision
Assess others effectively in manual handling and lifting techniques
