### Introduction:

The NEBOSH Diploma is *the* qualification for aspiring health and safety professionals, building directly on the foundation of knowledge provided by the NEBOSH National General Certificate. - \* Manage health and safety competence (both their own and that of their organization).
- \* Use a range of hazard identification, risk management and loss causation techniques.
- \* Monitor health and safety performance.
- \* Develop their role as a health and safety professional, including understanding how it links with Corporate Social Responsibility.
- \* Effectively manage organizational change.
- \* Manage contractors and supply chains.
- \* Control a range of workplace health and wellbeing issues.
- \* Control a range of workplace safety issues.

### Assessment:

There are 3 assessments for the Diploma. The assessments will be in the following format:

- Unit DN1: assignment;
- Unit DN2: case study; and
- Unit DN3: case study.

Throughout the programme our trainers will help you to prepare for the examination by developing your question reading and answering technique. This attention to the finer detail of the examination ensures that most of our candidates pass first time.

### Important:

Learners already enrolled onto the November 2015 specification cannot be transferred to the new specification.
